LB 102 AMENDMENT OF BYLAWS **Originating Document – LB-28-2013** **Effective Date – March 6, 2013** **Last Modified – March 6, 2013**

1. Principle:

Bylaws are the fundamental governing rules of the board. The purpose of this bylaw is to state the conditions under which bylaws are amended.

2. Policy

- 2.1** Bylaws may be amended in response to legislation or when circumstances change.
- 2.2** Bylaws may be amended by any member of the board can propose a review or an amendment of a bylaw.

3. Communication

- 3.1** All members of the board will receive notice and details of changes at the board meeting prior to the meeting at which time a motion for amendment may be tabled.
- 3.2** A motion to add, amend or remove a bylaw shall require a majority vote of at least two thirds of the members in order to be carried.
